Due Diligence – States require any holder in possession of unclaimed property to send written notification to the property owner's last known address prior to the funds being remitted to the state. Special attention must be given to which properties require letters, method of mailing, and language to be included in each notice. Ryan manages state mandated due diligence on your behalf to ensure compliance with a myriad of these requirements and to assist you in reducing your overall exposure. This service includes creating mailings in accordance with each jurisdiction's unique requirements and compiling responses that are received.

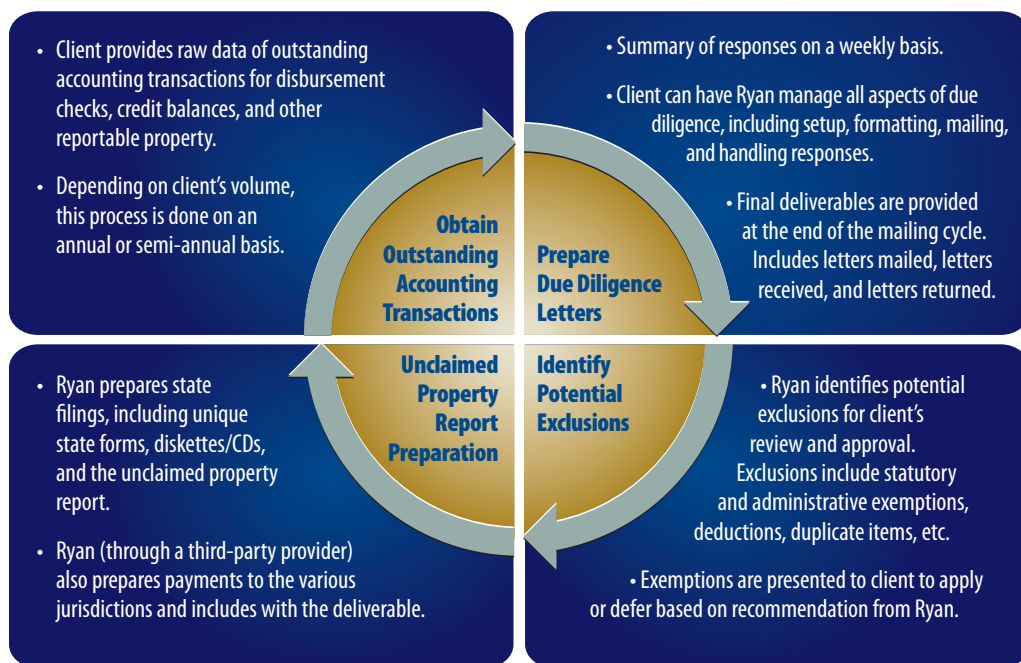
Exemption Analysis – Several states offer some type of exemption, deferral, or deduction. In an effort to prevent over-reporting to any given jurisdiction, and to seek liability reducing opportunities for our clients, our team examines your records to identify all statutory and administrative exemptions, deferrals, and deductions to ensure you only report what is required by law. In some instances, our team identifies exempt property that exceeds the cost to outsource compliance to Ryan.

State Report Preparation – Our compliance team prepares reporting packages in accordance with each state's requirements. The deliverable includes all required state verifications and checklists, an electronic file of the properties to remit in the state-required format, and a summary of items remitted to the various jurisdictions. In some instances, we can save our clients time and money by filing on a consolidated basis—meaning we file multiple Federal Employer Identification Numbers (FEINs) under one main operating entity.

Payment Preparation to States – Ryan simplifies the payment process by preparing checks payable to the reporting jurisdictions. A single electronic transfer eliminates the need to establish vendor accounts for each state, saving you valuable time.
